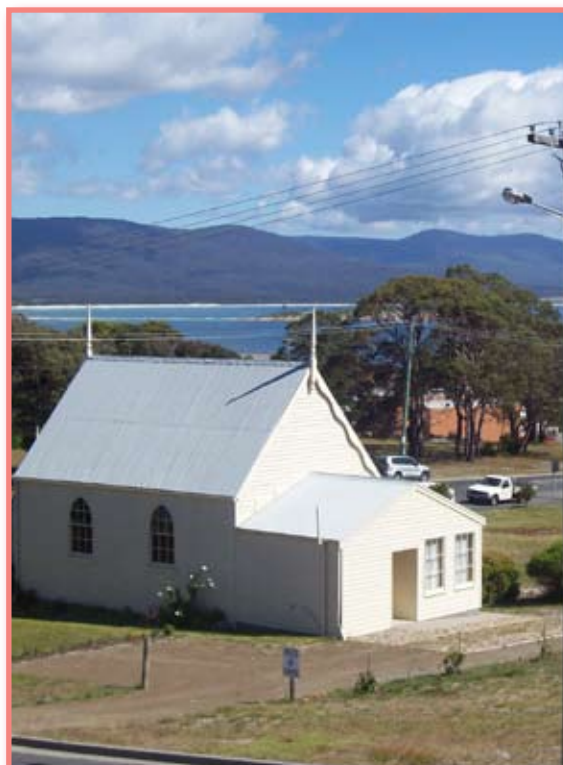

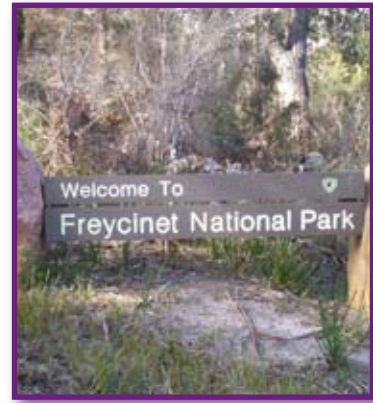
DAY 3: LE FROG MOTOR BIKE TRIKE RIDES & NATURE WORLD

DAY 4: FREYCINET NATIONAL PARK & EASTER EGG HUNT
