General

All holidays depart from Melbourne. For those outside Melbourne, we can arrange transfers or pickups along the route (additional charges apply).

Airfares are not included unless stated, but as a licensed travel agency, we can arrange flights for you.

Pre and post tour support, including overnight support, can be arranged as needed (surcharges apply).

Travel insurance is strongly recommended for all travellers and is mandatory for cruises and international holidays. Our travel coordinators can offer competitive travel insurance quotes tailored to your trip.

NDIS

Leisure Options is a nationally registered NDIS service provider, and we are dedicated to ensuring that your holiday is fully supported in line with NDIS guidelines. The NDIS funds the support hours you require for travel, which means your holiday can be tailored to meet your individual care and support needs. While the NDIS covers the support you need to access and enjoy your holiday, it does not cover costs like accommodation, meals, or transport.

For NDIS Participants

If you're using your NDIS funding for your holiday, the total group price will be divided into two parts:

1. **NDIS Invoice** – this covers your support hours and any NDIS line items related to the assistance you'll receive on tour.
2. **Participant Invoice** – this includes your personal holiday costs such as accommodation, meals, transport and activities.

Together, these two invoices make up the total holiday price shown in this brochure.

Please note that personal expenses like flights (unless stated), spending money, and travel insurance are not included in the listed prices and will be charged separately.

If you're unsure how this works, our friendly team is always happy to help explain your holiday quote and answer any questions.

HOLIDAY RATIOS

All Leisure Options holidays are tailored to provide you with the greatest enjoyment. To ensure we can cater for your needs and deliver safe experiences, we have developed holiday ratios to provide you with the appropriate level of care. The ratios indicate the number of staff members on a holiday for each traveller. Select your care requirements to determine your holiday ratio – if you have care requirements across multiple ratios you will travel as your lowest ratio to allow Leisure Options to provide you with the safest level of support.

1:4/1:3 Ratio

For travellers who are primarily independent in all areas of personal care and meals and have appropriate social skills when out in the community.

Living Situation

- living independently in supported accommodation or with family members

Personal Care

- independent with all activities of daily living including showering, shaving, toileting or brushing teeth
- requires a minimal amount of prompting with personal hygiene (such as help adjusting shower temperature or choosing appropriate clothes)

Meals

- able to eat independently and appropriately and capable of preparing beverages
- is confident in a restaurant and other public places
- requires minimal assistance to select meals or cutting of food

Money

- can manage their spending money with minimal assistance

Behaviour

- has good social skills in the community
- understands road rules and can stay with the group on outings
- able to handle a full day of activities in the community and can follow instructions
- no behavioural issues or challenging social conduct

1:2 Ratio

For travellers who require greater assistance with personal care and meals, those that use mobility aids or enjoy slower paced travel and those needing close supervision when out in the community.

Living Situation

- living in supported accommodation or with family members

Personal Care

- requires some assistance with activities of daily living including showering, shaving, toileting or brushing teeth
- requires prompting to select appropriate clothes and some assistance with dressing
- may use continence aids

Meals

- requires assistance during mealtimes and supervision to eat appropriately
- needs assistance when dining in restaurants and in public
- needs observation when eating and drinking due to mild dysphagia and may have a mealtime management plan

Money

- requires support in handling of spending money

Behaviour

- requires closer supervision in the community and on outings
- needs prompting to stay with the group
- displays some mild behaviours of concern

1:1 Ratio

Travellers who require full assistance with personal care, meals and require supervision in the community. This also includes travellers in manual or electric wheelchairs who are able to transfer independently or with guidance.

Living Situation

- living in supported accommodation or with family members

Personal Care

- requires full assistance with activities of daily living including showering, shaving, toileting or brushing teeth
- requires assistance with dressing, choosing clothes
- may use continence aids and requires assistance to change

Meals

- has special requirements during mealtimes and needs assistance to eat such as being fed by staff
- needs meals to be cut up or modified and will likely have a mealtime management plan
- requires full assistance and constant supervision when dining in restaurants
- has mild to moderate dysphagia not exceeding Level 2 for liquids and Level 5 for food. Anything beyond these levels, Leisure Options cannot support

Money

- requires full support in handling of spending money

Behaviour

- requires full assistance and supervision in the community and on outings
- can display some mild behaviours of concern

Independent

- Travellers with good social and communication skills
- Independent in personal care and activities of daily living
- Have good mobility and can eat independently in restaurants
- Understands and follows directions
- Can stay with the group on outings, or meet back with the group at specified time and venue

Active

- Travellers that can cope with a faster paced holiday
- Safely manage all forms of public transport
- Manage days with a substantial amount of walking
- Good fitness level and meets the independent criteria

Extra Assistance Personal Care

- Travellers who require assistance with showering, toileting, other areas of personal care, meals and activities of daily living

Extra Assistance Mobility

- Travellers who require extra assistance with walking or uses a mobility aid such as a walking frame or wheelchair for distance
- Can manage a regular bus or coach or a few stairs

Physical Disability

- Travellers who requires a wheelchair or walking frame for mobility along with accessible accommodation, facilities and transport

If an alternative is not available or not acceptable to you, you will be entitled to either a full refund of monies actually paid to Leisure Options or transfer to another holiday without a transfer fee.

COMPLAINTS AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Complainants may be made at any time in writing or verbally by travellers, their family members or carers, service providers, community organisations or anyone who is unhappy about any service provided. All complaints will be dealt with in a timely and fair manner.

IF YOU CANCEL

Subject to the Australian Consumer Law, cancellation charges for both you and your representative apply where a holiday or booking is cancelled. Written notice of the cancellation must be given to Leisure Options. The cancellation charges below are in addition to any payment made or owed to a third party provider (eg airline, hotel, tour operator):

Domestic Holidays

- 60 days or more prior to travel - loss of deposit
- 31-59 days prior to travel - 50% of total cost
- 30 days or less prior to travel - 100% of total cost

International Holidays

- 120 days or more prior to travel - Loss of deposit
- 91-119 days prior to travel - 50% of total cost
- 0-90 days prior to travel - 100% of total cost
